Dear Cal State Fullerton Fall 2004 Admitted Student:

My Cal State Fullerton colleagues and I hope that this note finds you in successful pursuit of your educational goals.

Our records show that you were offered Fall 2004 admission and that you did not enroll. At the time that we were preparing for the Fall 2004 semester, the prospects for increased state funding were not very good. In fact, a budget cut for the CSU was planned. However, that situation changed when the Governor and the California Legislature reached a settlement which restored some financial resources to the California State University.

Additional classes have been added to our Spring 2005 schedule, and almost all categories of Spring 2005 admission are open. These openings include categories that have not been open in several years, including lower division transfers (with 50 or more transferable units), undeclared post baccalaureate students, second BA/BS candidates and even first-time freshmen. These join the normally open categories of upper division transfer, masters and educational credentials in being open for Spring 2005 admissions.

Both the Fullerton and El Toro campuses are open for Spring 2005 admissions.
