D. Degree Structure of Undergraduate Curricula from September 1996

Since September 1996, the University has adopted the credit unit system for all undergraduates (except BDS, MBBS, BNurs(Full time) and BNurs(Part time)). The number of credits is normally indicative of the contact hours, study time and/or student workload associated with the course. Students who satisfactorily complete courses in the undergraduate programme or not less than 240 credits of course work will normally complete not less than 180 credits of courses in a 3-year full-time undergraduate programme, in the name specified in the syllabus.
