Admission as a Summer Visiting Student in 2010

3. Upon receipt of the signed Notice of Admission and the payment advice, the registration documents will be issued to you. If no reply is received by the due date, you shall be deemed to have declined this offer which shall accordingly be withdrawn.
4. You are not regarded as a Summer Visiting Student until you have paid the prescribed fees and a Student Registration Card has been issued to you.
5. The University may, at its discretion, request you to produce original copies of certificates and any other relevant documentation in support of all qualifications indicated in your application, regardless of whether such documents have been previously submitted. Should there be any discrepancy between your original documents and the qualifications indicated in your application, the University has the right to withdraw at any time the offer of admission and/or to treat any acceptance of the offer as null and void. Fees paid may be refunded, wholly or in part, at the discretion of the University.
6. It is your responsibility to comply with the academic timetables as laid down by the University and the Faculty, particularly with respect to the dates of assignment submission. Please consult the Faculty Office via email sumins@hku.hk in case of doubt.
7. Your attention is also drawn to General Regulation G15(c) which reads:
"A visiting student shall not change his status to that of a candidate for a degree, diploma or other University qualification; and shall not be granted any exemption from any part of the curriculum for any degree, diploma or other University qualification on the basis of work done during any period of his attendance as a visiting student."
