## LSE-PKU Summer School Transcript Academic Session 2010

The course of study followed and the grade obtained were:

Course: **China and the World: Chinese foreign policy since 1949**

Grade: **A-**

This Summer School has been running in China since 2003. Courses are comparable in standard with courses of a similar nature offered as part of degree programmes at LSE and Peking University (PKU), and are taught by LSE and PKU faculty. All courses are full time and consist of a total of 36 hours of lectures and 12 hours of classes over two weeks. The language of instruction for all courses is English. The final grade is based on the overall mark achieved for the course, including assessed course work and a final examination.

The examiners for each course have determined a grade for each student based on the following scale, which is used to convert numerical marks into letter grades. The scale also indicates the number of students achieving each Grade amongst those who completed all elements of assessment for the above named Course.
