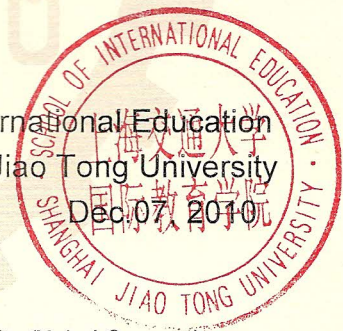
DEAR MR. ROY YEW HUNG CHAN:

1. Be sure to enter China with F visa, otherwise you will be responsible for all the possible consequences.
2. Please prepare four copies of the photo the same size as in the passport(5.5cm×4.5cm).
3. Aliens who do not lodge at hotels, guesthouses or dormitories for foreign students shall, within 24 hours (72 hours in rural areas) of entry, go through accommodation registration at local police station.
4. The dormitory will be kept for you till Feb.23, 2011 (The accommodation fees should be paid by semester and will not be refunded if you leave during the semester)
